Oct. 26, 2021 HBRA Directors Meeting Via Zoom Minutes

Update on creek work at lot 63.

The grounds director has reviewed the work in the creek by lot 63 and discussed this with the member. It has been agreed that any future work to secure this bank will wait until the committee assigned to make recommendations on how to secure the riparian areas has had a chance to meet and make recommendations. No further action will be taken at this time.

Note: In the Oct. 6th directors minutes it was noted "As mentioned at the Sept 5, 2021 AGM, cement should not be used below the high water mark in riparian areas. For HBRA, lots from 29 through 66 are considered in the riparian area." This was not correct. Riparian areas in our park are any areas that border on water (lake or creek) so in HBRA lots 22 through 71 are considered riparian and cement should not be used below the high water mark. Any changes to secure for erosion should be referred to the directors for review.

Follow up Lot 52 plans.

Lot 52 submitted plans to raise the current wall on the creek side of their lot to be level with their neighbors. Cinder blocks were proposed for this. This request has been denied for now since it involves cement below the high water mark. This can be revisited after recommendations have been made by the committee that will be reviewing ways to secure the creek.

Follow up Lot 40 plans.

Detailed plans have been received and reviewed for improvements to lot 40. The cement pad for the trailer has been approved. The cement pad on the lake side has not been approved since it involves cement below the high water mark and is outside of the lot dimensions. The placement of the shed and cabana in these plans appear correct and the member has been asked to submit plans for construction of the structures.

Review Committee Volunteers and discuss next steps

Thanks to everyone who volunteered to participate in the committees.

Committee to secure the perimeter fence on the grass (lots 1 – 22).

We have only had 4 members report issues with the perimeter fence on their lots. Lots 7, 8, 10 and 11 have reported that the back fence on their lots needs repair. Don Robertson (7), Andy Laidlaw (11) and Andrew Denis (82) have volunteered to help with this. Andrew (Grounds Director) will form a work party in the spring to organize this work. 2: around lot 68. On the straight stretch by Lakers Lane.
3: by lot 8. On the straight stretch where the cement ends by the gate.
4: by the playground, across from the caretakers garden.

secure your RV's and sheds. There is lots of information online regarding methods to discourage rats and block entry (ie. They don't like to chew through metal or steal wool) Use of poison is discouraged due to the potential risk to pets and children.
