When cleaning up your lots –

The compost area should only be used for **grass and leaves**.

The burn pit is to be used for **pruned branches and woody debris**. **Putting treated or painted wood, roof shingles or anything non-organic contaminates the burn**. Please don't do it.

(**NOTE:** To eliminate a large debris pile in the burn pit and prevent a fire hazard in the summer, we ask that no dumping take place **after July 1st**).

Rocks can be dumped over the bank behind the compost area, on the creek side of the berm. **DO NOT** put concrete chunks into the creek.

When planning lot improvements, please consult our rules (found on our website) then submit your plans/drawings for approval in advance of beginning the work. You can submit them to [hbragrounds@gmail.com](mailto:hbragrounds@gmail.com) or [hbrasecretary@gmail.com](mailto:hbrasecretary@gmail.com). Directors will review the changes to help ensure compliance to the rules and to ensure boundary lines aren't affected. If possible, please discuss changes with your neighbours as well.

We have 2 Dumpsters. One for your RV garbage and another for recycling items.

These dumpsters will be available for use by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Please review what is approved for recycling before dropping it in the bin. Throwing non approved items in the bin contaminates it, meaning the company may refuse to take it or we could be fined. Also **please DO NOT leave old lawn chairs, BBQ's, propane bottles, carpets, golf clubs, etc. beside the bins** - Any **large unwanted items** can be dropped off on your way home at:

- 1.) Meade Creek, Youbou Rd, Lake Cowichan
- 2.) Bings Creek, Drinkwater Rd, Duncan. **Its Free**
